#### 1.1 **PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:**

Bidders for this tender shall meet the following Pre Qualification Experience and Financial criteria:

#### 1.1.1 Experience Criteria:

1.1.1.1 Bidder as a PMC (Project Management Consultant) (or) EPCM (Engineering, Procurement, Construction Management) Consultant should have executed a contract for construction of at least one Induced draft type RCC (Reinforced Cement Concrete) Cooling Tower, which shall comprise not less than (3) three cells, each cell of capacity not less than 1800 Cu.M/Hr.



- 1.1.1.2 Scope of qualifying contract shall comprise of all the following:
  - (a) Design of cooling tower or approval of their sub contractor's design
  - (b) Materials management
  - (c) Construction management
  - (d) Commissioning activities
- 1.1.1.3 Qualifying contract should have been executed in a new grass root plants / units (or) as addition of existing facilities (or) Revamp of existing plants / units in any of the Refineries (or) Fertilizers Plants (or) Power Sector Plants (or) Oil & Gas Processing Plants (or) Petrochemical Plants, during the last Seven (7) Years period reckoned prior to 31.01.2017.

#### 1.1.2 Financial Criteria:

- 1.1.2.1 The bidder's audited annual financial turnover during one of the preceding three financial years i.e. 2013-14, 2014-15 & 2015-16 shall be atleast Rs. 42.20 Lakhs.
- 1.1.2.2 Net worth for the last audited financial year i.e. 2015-16 should not be negative.

#### 1.1.3 Other Qualifying Criteria:

- 1.1.3.1 The bidder should submit documentary proof for their compliance to the qualification experience criteria viz. Work order & Job completion certificate and Finance Criteria viz. Audited financial statements.
- 1.1.3.2 Bidder shall ensure submission of complete information / documentation. CPCL reserves the right to complete the evaluation based on the details furnished by the agencies without seeking any subsequent additional information.
- 1.1.3.3 Experience and Financial Turnover of the bidding entity only shall be considered. Bidder's in-house work experience (where for the past experience referred for qualification, the contractor and the owner belong to the same organization which includes subsidiaries/parent Company) shall not be considered as valid experience for the purpose of qualification.
- 1.1.3.4 CPCL reserves the right to use their in-house information for assessment of Bidder's capabilities.
- 1.1.3.5 Bids on consortium or JV basis are not acceptable.
- 1.1.3.6 Bidder submitting their bids should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceeding. The bidder should not be in the Holiday / Negative list of CPCL or its Administrative Ministry (MoPNG).
- 1.1.3.7 If the performance of the Bidder is / has been found to be unsatisfactory for any reasons whatsoever, in any organization including CPCL, then CPCL reserves the right to reject the bids submitted by such bidders.
- 1.1.3.8 For evaluation of PQ Criteria, the past contract value of the bidders shall be multiplied by a correction factor for each completed year as given below:

#### 1.2 INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CONTRACTORS / BIDDERS FOR THE E-SUBMISSION OF THE BIDS ONLINE THROUGH THE E-TENDER SITE OF CPCL.

- 1.2.1 Bidder should do the registration in the tender site https://cpcletenders.gov.in using the option available. Then the Digital Signature registration has to be done with the e-token, after logging into the site. The e-token may be obtained from one of the authorized Certifying Authorities such as SIFY/TCS / nCode.eMudhra.
- 1.2.2 Bidder then need to login to the site thro' their user ID/ password chosen during registration.
- 1.2.3 The e-token that is registered should be used by the bidder only and should ensure safety of the same.
- 1.2.4 The Bidders can update well in advance, the documents such as certificates, purchase order details etc., under My Documents option and these can be selected as per tender requirements and then send along with bid documents during bid submission.
- 1.2.5 After downloading / getting the tender schedules, the Bidder should go thro' them carefully and then submit the documents as asked, otherwise, the bid will be rejected.
- 1.2.6 If there are any clarifications, this may be obtained online thro' the tender site, or thro' the contact details. Bidder should take into account of the corrigendum published before submitting the bids online.
- 1.2.7 Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender schedule and they should be in PDF/xls/rar/dwf formats. If there is more than one document, they can be clubbed together.
- 1.2.8 Bidder should submit the EMD (if applicable) as specified in the tender. The original should be posted/couriered/given in person to the Tender Inviting Authority, within the bid submission due date & time for the tender. Scanned copy of the instrument should be uploaded as part of the offer along with techno bid.
- 1.2.9 It is construed that the bidder has read all the terms and conditions before submitting their offer.
- 1.2.10 The bidder has to submit the tender document online well in advance before the prescribed time to avoid any delay or problem during the submission process.
- 1.2.11 After the bid submission, the acknowledgement number, given by the e-tendering system should be printed by the bidder and kept as a record of evidence for online submission of bid for the particular tender.
- 1.2.12 The details of the Earnest Money Deposit (if applicable) document should be submitted physically to the Dept and the scanned copies should be furnished at the time of bid submission online. They should be same, otherwise the Tender will be summarily rejected.



- 1.2.13 The Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will not be held responsible for any sort of delay or the difficulties faced during the submission of bids online by the bidders.
- 1.2.14 The tendering system will give a successful bid updation message after uploading all the bid documents submitted & then a bid summary will be shown with the bid no, date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details. The documents submitted by the bidders will be digitally signed using the e-token of the bidder and then submitted.
- 1.2.15 The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement as a token of the submission of the bid. The bid summary will act as a proof of bid submission for a tender floated and will also act as an entry point to participate in the bid opening date.
- 1.2.16 Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he submits the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission end time. If there is any delay, due to other issues, bidder only is responsible.
- 1.2.17 Each document to be uploaded thro' online for the tenders should be less than 2 MB. If any document is more than 2MB, it can be converted to rar/zip format and then the same can be uploaded. However if the file size is less than 1 MB the transaction uploading time will be very fast. The total size of the documents in all the covers put together, should be less than or equal to 12MB.
- 1.2.18 The bidder should see that the bid documents submitted should be free from virus and if the documents could not be opened, due to virus, during tender opening, the bid is liable to be rejected.
- 1.2.19 The time settings fixed in the server side & displayed at the top of the tender site, will be valid for all actions of requesting, bid submission, bid opening etc., in the e-tender system. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- 1.2.20 All the data being entered by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered will not viewable by unauthorized persons during bid submission & not be viewable by any one until the time of bid opening. Overall, the submitted tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized individual.
- 1.2.21 The confidentiality of the bids is maintained since the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology is used. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done.
- 1.2.22 The bidders are requested to submit the bids through online e-tendering system to the TIA well before the bid submission end date & time (as per Server System Clock).
- 1.2.23 The bidder should logout of the tendering system using the normal logout option available at the top right hand corner and not by selecting the (X) exit option in the browser.
- 1.2.24 Bidders should ensure that prices should not be indicated anywhere in the unpriced part. The prices should be indicated only in the price bid and no where else.
- 1.2.25 Bidders to note that if prices are indicated in their unpriced techno commercial part their offer will be rejected and NO further evaluation or communication will be entertained in this regard.
- 1.2.26 Bidders to note that the very act of using DSC for downloading the bids and uploading their offers shall be deemed to be a confirmation that they have read all sections and pages of the bid document including General conditions of contract without any

exception and have understood the entire document and are clear about the requirements of the tender requirements.

1.2.27 Deviations if any shall be stated in the format as per Annexure-3.2 to ITB (Compliance to Bid Requirement) and shall be uploaded in the e-tender website.

#### 1.3.2 BID OPENING:

- 1.3.2.1 Part-A (Mandatory) Bid shall be opened on the date and time mentioned in the tender.
- 1.3.2.2 Part-B (Techno-Commercial) Bid shall be opened on the date and time mentioned in the tender only if necessary documents are furnished in Part-A.
- 1.3.2.3 Part-C (Price Bid) of only those bidders, whose offer is found techno-commercially acceptable, shall be opened on a later date as per convenience of CPCL after intimation to the qualified bidders.

#### 1.4 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) / BID SECURITY:

Bidders shall submit the following statutory approvals viz., PF registration code number, ESI registration code number, Income Tax PAN number and Service tax registration Certificates on their own Company's along with the techno-commercial bid without which they will not be considered for price bid opening. In other words if non-compliance of the above is observed in their offer, will be summarily rejected in the techno-commercial stage itself.
